

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2019-02 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Diamond City, Arkansas deems it necessary to amend all previous Ordinances including Ordinance 2019-02 for modifying the description, Job and Wages of the Building Inspector for the City of Diamond City.

Section 1: The Planning and Zoning Commission has adopted the new Diamond City Building Permit Application

Section 2: In order to pay the Building Inspector, the Building Inspector will be paid one half of the Building Permit Fee, based on the table listed on the Building permit. When this fee is paid, it will be made out to the City of Diamond City. The City will than pay the Building Inspector by check

Section 3: The Building Permit Application will be filled out by the applicant, than given to the Building Inspector. At this time the Building Inspector will figure the cost for the application based on the table listed and let the applicant know the amount to pay to City Hall.

Section 4: Any additional fees that may incur during the building will be paid to the City of Diamond City and the City will pay the Building Inspector the total amount of those fees.


Section 5: All checks will be made out to the City of Diamond City.

Section 6: No benefits will be offered and no code Enforcement jobs will be done.

Section 7: The previsions of the Ordinance are hereby declared to be servable and if any provision shall for any reason be held illegal or invalid, such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the Ordinance.

Section 8: EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is determined by the City Council that the adoption of this Ordinance is immediately necessary to provide clarity to the employees of the City of Diamond City, Arkansas and to protect the interest of the City of diamond City, Arkansas and an emergency is hereby declared and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect form and after passage and publication.
