ORDINANCE 02-2023 USE OF DOWNSTREAM METER FOR THE MONTHS OF APRIL THROUGH OCTOBER

WHEREAS: The City of Diamond City, Arkansas has decided that the use of downstream meters during the months of April through October would be beneficial to the citizens of Diamond City, Arkansas.

THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DIAMOND CITY, ARKANSAS THAT:

SECTION 1: A downstream meter may be picked up by a Diamond City resident on or after the 1st day of April at Diamond City Administration Building. The resident will have to hook it up to an outside spigot only. If there is any additional cost hooking it to the spigot this cost is on the resident. This meter is to be used for outdoor use only.

SECTION 2: A refundable deposit of \$30.00 and the proper paperwork will need to be filled out to get the meter. The read on the meter will be the start of the read for water usage.

SECTION 3: The downstream water meter will be returned to the Diamond City Administration Building on or before October 31st of that year. The read on the meter when it is returned will be the end read.

SECTION 4: No downstream water meter will be read April 1 through October 31. City Employees will not be going on the property to read the meter. Once the meter has been returned to the City a credit will be applied to the residents account for the difference in sewer only. This will be a onetime credit issued in November.

SECTION 5: If the downstream meter is not returned by October 31 of that year, the resident will not be intitled to the credit.

SECTION 6: If it is found the resident is using the downstream water meter in any way other than for outside use the City will take the meter and no refund or credit will be given.

SECTION 7: This ordinance is declared servable and if any provision shall for any reason be held illegal or invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the reminder of this ordinance.
