

RESOLUTION 05-2015

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF DIAMOND CITY, ARKANSAS
TO WAIVE LOCAL AND STATE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE
PURCHASE OF A POLICE VEHICLE**

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Diamond City has heard from City Staff that competitive bidding is not practicable in obtaining a police vehicle for the specific needs of the Police Department in Diamond City. Competitive bidding for the required expenditure, in this case a police vehicle with a cost of approximately \$25,000.00 is not practical especially considering the local purchasing requirements of the City of Diamond City. Therefore, the staff undertook a careful process to ensure that the best possible vehicle was selected for the very specific needs of the Police Department, including the best warranty, the best maintenance record and reliability, and the best ability to easily and reliably use the tools required to fit the Police Department needs in Diamond City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
DIAMOND CITY, ARKANSAS:**


SECTION I: Pursuant to state law and city ordinances the City of Diamond City, Arkansas hereby waives the requirement of competitive bidding for the purchase of a police vehicle for the City of Diamond City.
