ORDINANCE 15-2022

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 06-2021 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Diamond City, Arkansas deems it necessary to amend certain sections of the previous Ordinances 06-2021 for the payment process to the Building Inspector for the City of Diamond City. This is to avoid any confusion on payment from the city and to the Building Inspector.

Section 1: The Planning and Zoning Commission has adopted the new Diamond City Building Permit Application

Section 2: In order to pay the Building Inspector, the Building Inspector will be paid 50% (fifty percent) of the Building Permit based on the table rate listed on the building permit fee form. When this fee is paid, it will be made out to the City of Diamond City. The City will then pay the Building Inspector 25% (twenty-five percent) of the total amount of the building permit after he has submitted a copy of the check and the deposit slip to the Treasurer. When the COO has been issued to the homeowner and a copy of the COO has been given to the Treasurer the other 25% (twenty-five percent) will be submitted for payment

Section 3: Any additional fees that may incur during the building will be paid to the City of Diamond City and the City will pay the Building Inspector the total amount of those fees. If there are any re-inspection a form must be submitted to the Treasurer for payment.


Section 4: The provisions of the Ordinance are hereby declared to be servable and if any provision shall for any reason be held illegal or invalid, such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the Ordinance.

Section 5: EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is determined by the City Council that the adoption of this Ordinance is immediately necessary to provide clarity to the employees of the City of Diamond City, Arkansas and to protect the interest of the City of Diamond City, Arkansas and an emergency is hereby declared and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage and publication.
